- There are roles for everyone regardless of ability!


We have several committees that need <u>YOUR</u> special skills including:

# Grand Opening of the Michelle Obama Neighborhood Library Saturday, Sept 10 at 59th St. and Atlantic Ave.


This library, on the site of the former Atlantic Theater, will replace the current North Library at 5571 Orange Ave. That library is about 6,800 square feet in a residential area.

The new library will offer 24,500 square feet of space, be Wi-Fi enabled

throughout and offer other technology including self-checkout and check-in kiosks, embedded hearing aid assists in meeting rooms, 3-D printers in the Learning Studio and more.

There will be 43 publicly accessible computers and additional computers, tablets and printers in the Learning Center and Learning Studio.

LPA Architects has incorporated a nautical theme throughout, with bubble accents and glass walls. It is being built to Silver LEED standards, and uses natural light extensively.
